Strongsville City Schools will now offer free
breakfast
and lunch to all students.

The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) Food and Nutrition Services published a nationwide waiver extension for the Summer Food Service Program and Seamless Summer Option through June 30, 2021 or until funds are exhausted

What this means for our district is we will be offering free meals to all students with this new waiver provided by the USDA and Ohio Department of Education. This program is an extension of the program that the USDA offered in the spring. All students are entitled to a free breakfast and lunch daily. Students will be able to choose a breakfast and lunch from the menus published at:

Starting Monday September 14th through June 30th, 2021!

SOLO Program Meal Pick up will still be offered on Wednesdays & Fridays.

All students who are in the SOLO program can now pick up 5 days' worth of breakfast and lunches every Wednesday from 1:15-2:00 at the Strongsville Middle School or at the Strongsville High School every Friday from 11:00-12:00. Students do not have to be present at pick up, and families can pick up for one another for any children that attend K-12 in the Strongsville City Schools.
