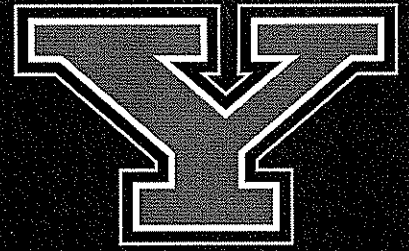

# Youngstown State University's College Credit Plus Pathways

College Credit Plus gives high school students the chance to earn college credit while they are still in high school at no cost to the student. Many high schools are able to offer YSU courses right in the high school building, so that students can take the classes as part of their regular school day. Students can also come to campus, and take classes on-line. The "Credit Pathways" shown to the right are examples of dual enrollment courses that will count towards degrees and transfer to other University System of Ohio colleges and universities. Of course, YSU also offers pathways for majors in STEM, health and human services, business, education, creative arts and communications, and liberal arts and social sciences. 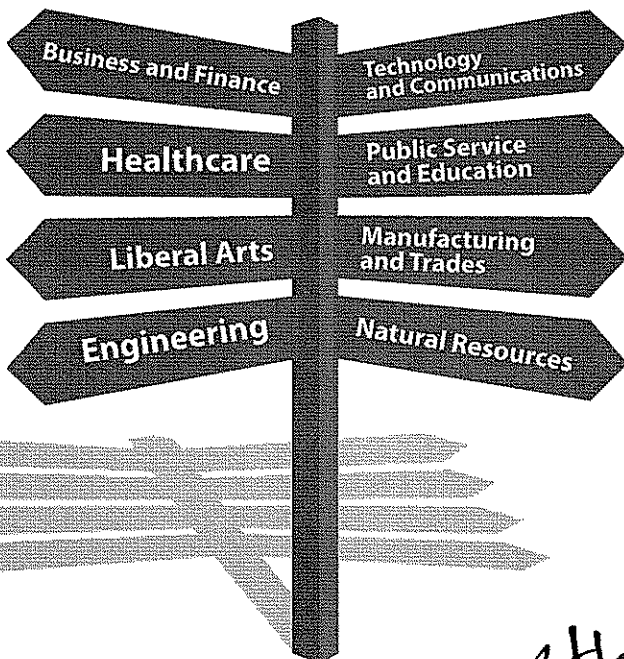
